The following are workers for the Actual Swim Meet but do not require SAIL training

They usually work ½ of each meet

- **Tent Control (keeps control of the swimmers under the tents, this person will need to be in place from the beginning of the meet)**
- **Swimmer Liner upper (calls the swimmers from the tents to send to clerk of course, this person will need to be at the meet 45 minutes before the start of the meet)**
- **Ribbons (places labels on the back of the ribbons and files them for the swimmer pickup. This person does not have to arrive until the meet starts but will work to finish after the Meet can take home and finish, but needs to be at the pool for Friday to give to swimmers)**
- **Hospitality: Workers during the meet will fill cups with ice and water and deliver on trays to volunteers around the pool deck) Make other Team Feel Welcome!**
- **Set Up (this will be on Wednesday evening before the meet) Coaches and Team Mom Help!**
- **Head Clean Up at Away meets (this is cleaning up the area where the Gower swimmers sat during away meets) Only 2 Away meets this Year!**
- **Assist Clean Up at Away Meets**
- **Head Clean Up at Home Meets (this is cleaning up where the swimmers sat and storing equipment and resetting the pool for operation the next day) If you like to Sit and Watch the meet this one is for you**
- **Assist Clean Up at Home Meets**
- **Spirit (tattoos)**
- **Assistant SAIL Rep**

The following are volunteer positions for the Team in areas other than the meets

- **Social Help with the Fun at the Socials Need Parents for each age level**
- **Spirit Help the Spirit Moms make treats for the Coaches or help with Spirit Events such as painting up or Red Division Week festivities.**
